



## Henley Town & Visitors' Regatta 2 August 2008

### NOTES FOR OFFICIALS

- All officials should report to the floating stand upon arrival, and at least 30 minutes (45 minutes for control commission) prior to the start of duty, where equipment will be issued at the start of the day. During the day equipment should be left at each position and passed to the next official.
- All safety officials must be in place prior to the first crews going afloat at the start of racing.
- At the start of the day, each official should undertake a radio check with Regatta Control.
- Two radio nets will be in use throughout the day. Umpire's launches, rescue boats, and Regatta Control will use one net, with Start and Crew Marshals on a second net which will also be connected to Regatta Control.
- The Race Committee is: Dave Hancock (chairman), John Duff, Rod Murray and Andrew Ruddle. There will always be at least one Race Committee representative in the Floating stand throughout the day.
- TRUC representative: Chris Sprague.
- The Environment Agency and the Royal Berkshire Hospital Reading have been advised that the regatta will be taking place.
- Safety Boats are being provided by Rowsafe.
- Ambulance is being provided by St. John Ambulance.
- In case of a major incident, contact the Safety Advisor using the radio net who alone will be responsible for dialling 999.
